## STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

### ◆ BOY, DIDN'T IT RAIN!

Most areas of Southeast Tennessee, including Athens, had more rain this past Monday than any 24-hour period on record. Depending on whose rain gauge you examined, the total amount of rain in Athens since Sunday afternoon was between 9 and 13 inches. The official measurement at Athens Utilities Board for the 24 hours from 7:30 a.m. Monday through 7:30 a.m. Tuesday was 8.89 inches. Of course, that did not include the Sunday afternoon and Sunday night rain.

### ◆ FIRE DESTROYS HISTORIC CHURCH

A McMinn County landmark has been destroyed by fire. Fire broke out at the old Lamontville Baptist Church on County Road 20 early Tuesday morning. The sanctuary was engulfed in flames by the time firefighters arrived. The building dates back to 1914.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ The major stock indexes fell more than 2 percent on Tuesday on fears that the euro zone's debt crisis is worsening and the U.S. economy is sliding back into recession. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed down 100.96 at 11,139.30.

◆ A new NBC/Wall Street Journal poll says President Obama's approval rating has hit another low and Rick Perry has surged to the lead in the 2012 Republican presidential race. According to the poll, just 37% approve of Obama's handling of the economy. That's a six-point drop since July. The poll shows the race for the Republican nomination is between Perry and Mitt Romney at this point. Perry now leads Romney, 38% to 23%. Ron Paul is third with 9% and Michele Bachmann is fourth with 8%.

◆ A JetBlue Airways flight to Florida was canceled and two flight attendants were checked at the hospital as a precaution after a suspicious powder was found aboard a plane at Boston's Logan Airport on Tuesday.

◆ A Chattanooga woman died early Tuesday when a tree fell on her car. She had gone outside during a drenching rainstorm to move the family's cars from the carport so they wouldn't be hit by falling tree limbs.

### Amish or Mennonite?

A lot of people in the Athens area may have visited the Delano Community Farm Market in Delano at one time or another. We commonly refer to the market as the "Amish" market. However, the market is actually operated by a community of Old Order Mennonites.

The community was located in Meigs County for several years until they dissolved. Some of them started a settlement at Delano and opened the Delano Community Farm Market where they sell 37 items of produce, including tomatoes, cucumbers, watermelons, peaches, strawberries, peach preserves, and salsa. All of the produce is homemade or grown on the community's farm. The market is open Monday through Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. from mid-April through October. They also have an animal sale open to the public the last Saturday of every month.

There are between 18 and 30 families living in the settlement. They travel by horse and buggy, although sometimes pay someone to transport them by automobile. They don't have a phone or electricity. They hold a church service each Sunday which normally lasts at least three hours. The women

sit on the right, the men on the left. The members of the community speak English and some also speak Pennsylvania Dutch. The settlement is made up of a mix of Mennonites, Amish, German Baptists, and others. The settlement is located on Needle Eye Lane off Highway 411 in Delano.
