◆ COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE:

- ✓ The Athens Kiwanis Club's annual Barbecue will take place today from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. in front of Belks Plaza. You can buy a pound of fresh hickory-smoked barbecue pulled pork to go for \$8. Proceeds will be used for the Kiwanis Club's mission of youth enrichment.
- ✓ In case you haven't noticed it, the City of Athens this week installed a much-needed traffic light with a left-turn signal on West Madison Avenue at Keith Lane.
- ✓ A coffee house concert fundraiser called "September Songs" will be held at The Arts Center in Athens tonight at 7:30 in the Sue E. Trotter Theater. September Songs features local singers and musicians in solo and ensemble performances. Tickets are \$10.
- ✓ The Etowah Parks & Recreation Department will host a free football party at the Gem Theater Saturday at 3 p.m. Everyone is invited to come enjoy the UT vs. Florida game live on the movie screen.
- ✓ The Athens Travelers Car Club holds a "cruise In" Saturday evening in downtown Athens. Streets will be closed from 4 to 10.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ House Speaker John Boehner dismisses President Obama's job-creation package as a "poor substitute" for policies that would boost the economy. Boehner says he favors tax reforms that would close loopholes, but not raise tax rates.
 - ◆ The White House says President Obama will not include any changes to Social Security in the deficit proposals he will send to Congress next week.
 - ◆ The Postal Service says it wants to end overnight delivery of letters and postcards. The agency lost more than \$3 billion last quarter and must downsize drastically or it will be forced to stop delivering mail by the end of next summer.
 - ◆ Stock prices climbed again on Thursday. The Dow Jones Industrial average closed up 186.45 at 11,433.18.
 - ◆ An intense fire in the engine room of the Norwegian cruise ship MS Nordlys killed two crewmen, injured nine others, and forced over 200 passengers to evacuate. Police suspect an on-board explosion.

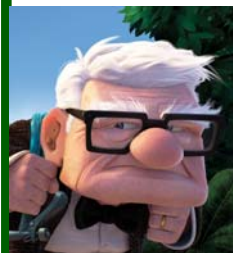
