#### ◆ MONROE CO. MARINE DIES IN AFGHANISTAN

Lance Corporal Franklyn Watson, 21, of Monroe County has been killed in Afghanistan. He was shot in the chest during an attack on his unit. Watson was a combat engineer in charge of disarming IED's. He graduated from Sequoyah High School in 2008 and was a part-time Madisonville police officer and a Monroe County sheriff's deputy before joining the Marines Corps.

### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Stocks rose in a choppy session on Monday on optimism that euro zone officials would slash Greece's debt and recapitalize European banks in an effort to tackle the region's credit problems. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed up 272.38 at 11,043.86.

◆ Businessman Herman Cain says his victory in the Florida Republican straw poll was authentic and was not a statement by voters against Texas Governor Rick Perry. Cain says that his performance shows "the voice of the people is more powerful than the voice of the media."

◆ New York City's Police Commissioner Ray Kelly says New York police can shoot down an airplane if needed. Kelly says the city's police department has built up extensive counterterrorism abilities after the September 11, 2001, attacks. He says the city could not rely on the federal government alone for protection from an attack. Kelly says in an extreme situation, New York City has means to take down a plane.

◆ Long-distance swimmer Diana Nyad decided to abandon her third attempt to swim from Cuba to Florida after being stung in the face and eyes by jellyfish. When she quit, she had finished more than 77 miles of the 103-mile stretch.

◆ When a robber broke into Rolanda Hill's home in Chattanooga, he stole both her money and her cell phone, thinking she would not be able to call the police without her phone. The 20-year-old Hill didn't let that get in her way, though. She reported the crime to her Facebook friends and asked them to call police. Police responded and at last report were still looking for the robber.
