### State & Local News

#### ◆ CALL HIM "DETECTIVE" VINCE GILL

Country singer Vince Gill has become the newest narcotics investigator at the McMinn County Sheriff's Office. Sheriff Joe Guy presented a customized badge with Gill's name engraved on it at Gill's recent charity concert for the Chattanooga Children's Advocacy Center. Sheriff Guy says Gill told him he has a deep concern over the problems of meth and prescription drug abuse statewide. McMinn County had the most meth



lab seizures in Tennessee in 2009 and 2010, but Sheriff Guy says efforts by law enforcement resulted in a 40% decrease in the number of labs in 2011.

### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Tuesday is presidential primary day in Florida. The polls show Mitt Romney with a commanding lead over Newt Gingrich. The Romney campaign has spent \$14 million on attack ads. That's more than four times what Gingrich has spent. Gingrich vows to press on with his campaign, no matter what happens in Florida. He hints that he is waiting patiently for Rick Santorum to drop out of the race and endorse him.

◆ Police in Florida suspect an arsonist may have started a smoky brush fire which mixed with dense moisture coming off of marshes and swamps and resulted in zero visibility along a stretch of I-75 early Sunday. Police say a Fed-Ex truck crashed and burst into flames. That started a domino effect with cars and trucks piling into each other on both sides of the interstate. Ten people were killed and 18 were injured.

◆ A former Massachusetts dentist has been sentenced to one year in jail for using paper clips instead of stainless steel posts when he performed root canals.

◆ A new study says measuring blood pressure on both arms, rather than only one, can reveal an elevated risk of heart disease. Researchers say a noticeable difference in the top number from one arm to the other may indicate heart trouble.

### ROBBERY SUSPECTS CAUGHT

Two of four suspects wanted in connection with a strong-armed robbery at the I-75 Southbound rest area in McMinn County have been captured in Lenoir City. The suspects are from Cincinnati and Kentucky. They allegedly assaulted a man from Philadelphia, TN, taking his cash and a gold necklace. A lookout was broadcast for their car, which was found abandoned on Railroad Ave. in Athens. A convenience store video showed two of the suspects getting into a Ford Taurus. The Taurus was soon located, with the driver stating that she had given a ride to the suspects to the Athens Lodge off Highway 305. Officers went to the Athens Lodge and discovered that the suspects had hitched a ride in another vehicle traveling northbound on I-75. A description of the vehicle was passed to police agencies along I-75. Lenoir City police stopped the car. The suspects fled, but were quickly apprehended. The other two suspects remain at large. The arrested suspects were identified as Danny Marcum, 41, of Cincinnati, and David Roseberry, 49, of Villa Hills, Kentucky.
