### Local & State News

#### ◆ 10 TENN. COUNTIES DECLARED DISASTERS

The Governor's office announced Saturday that the federal government has designated McMinn, Monroe, Bradley, Polk, Hamilton, and four other counties disaster areas due to storms and flooding between Feb. 29 and March 2. Residents who sustained losses in these counties can begin applying for assistance immediately through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), by registering online at [www.disasterassistance.gov](http://www.disasterassistance.gov) or by calling 1-800-621-FEMA (3362). #### ◆ TWO CRASHES CAUSE TWO FATALITIES

- A Decatur man, 60-year-old Johnny Kirkland Gore, died late Wednesday night from a single car wreck on Highway 30. He apparently lost control of his vehicle and was ejected through the moon roof. He was not wearing any safety restraints. The wreck was investigated by the Tennessee Highway Patrol.
- A single-vehicle wreck on Denso Drive Thursday morning caused the death of Harold Dean Hutsell, age 77, of Athens. According to the Athens Police Department report, the red Chevy Blazer that Hutsell was driving, was sitting in an upright position and had appeared to have rolled at least one time. The vehicle apparently left the roadway and struck the guardrail. Hutsell was not wearing any safety restraints. EMS on the scene confirmed he was deceased.

### NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Mitt Romney scored an overwhelming win Sunday in Puerto Rico's Republican presidential primary, trouncing chief rival Rick Santorum, and getting another 20 delegates. The two rivals will have more competitive races this week in Illinois and Louisiana.
- ◆ Gunmen linked to al Qaeda shot dead an American teacher in Yemen, accusing him of Christian "proselytizing".
- ◆ Former Republican Presidential Candidate and current Senator, John McCain, says the Republican campaign to choose a candidate to take on the President in November is "the nastiest" ever.
- ◆ House Republicans will try this week to seize control of the election-year spending debate by rolling out a plan to slash trillion-dollar deficits and revive controversial reforms to the Medicare healthcare program for the elderly.
- ◆ Apple's new iPad 3 that went on sale last Friday, is costing Apple about 9% more to manufacture than the iPad 2, which debuted a year ago. Over half the components are being made by Samsung Corporation, including the new high resolution display.
- ◆ Stock prices rose sharply last week, led by financial stocks. The Dow rose 311 points to end the week at 13,233, up 2.4%.
- ◆ Of all the teams in the running for Peyton Manning, the Titans might just have the sweetest deal. But not because of what owner Bud Adams has put on the table. Nashville-based Shoney's has offered the free agent quarterback a free stack of their famous flapjacks every day for the remainder of his career if he chooses to play football in Music City.

### THIS DAY IN HISTORY - MARCH 19

**1848** - Wyatt Earp was born in Illinois. He was an assistant marshal in Dodge City, Kansas. Later, he and his two brothers--along with Doc Holliday--forced a showdown with the Ike Clanton outlaw gang in the famous gunfight at the OK Corral in Tombstone, Arizona.

**1860** - William Jennings Bryan was born. He was a member of Congress, U.S. Secretary of State, and unsuccessful candidate for president. In 1925, he assisted the prosecution in the trial of John T. Scopes in Dayton, TN. Scopes was accused of teaching evolution in a public school. Bryan died in Dayton shortly after the trial ended. Bryan College in Dayton is named for him.

**1937** - Singer Clarence "Frogman" Henry was born. His hit records include "Ain't Got No Home" and "But I Do." -According to legend, March 19th is the day the swallows return to the mission of San Juan Capistrano in California after spending the winter in the south.
