STATE & LOCAL NEWS

◆ CHEMICAL SPILL IN DECATUR

There were some anxious moments in Decatur Thursday morning after a chemical spill inside the Cymer Corporation Plant on Cymer Lane. The spill resulted in a brief chemical leak into the atmosphere. The chemical was an agent used to decompose plastic. An evacuation was ordered at businesses in the immediate area. However, before the evacuation process was completed, the company said the leak had been contained. Authorities say there were no reports of any person experiencing any symptoms as a result of the leak.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Florida Senator Marco Rubio has thrown his support behind Republican presidential candidate Mitt Romney. Rubio is frequently mentioned as a likely running mate. Rubio says Romney offers a stark contrast to President Obama's record.
- ◆ Authorities have filed criminal charges against the JetBlue Airways pilot who yelled incoherently about religion and bombs and pounded on a locked cockpit door before passengers subdued him. The Justice Department charged Capt. Clayton Osbon with interfering with the crew. He faces up to 20 years in prison if convicted.
- ◆ New jobless claims fell to a 4-year low last week, but failed to meet forecasts. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 19.61 at 13,145.82.
- ◆ Electronics retailer Best Buy says it will close 50 of its large store locations and lay off at least 400 workers in a cost-cutting move. Best Buy's sales are being affected by online purchases of electronic items.
- ◆ In Austria, a 56-year-old unemployed man cut off his own foot with a mitre saw so he could continue receiving jobless benefits. He then threw his foot into the fireplace so it would not be possible to reattach it.
