The ceremony will be held at Cokesbury United Methodist Church on Kingston Pike in Knoxville. The college's Baccalaureate service will be held at 8 p.m. Friday in Townsend Memorial Hall on the Athens campus. The three-day celebration concludes on Saturday at 9 a.m. in Nocatula Gardens when more than 240 graduates will walk across the stage in the formal Commencement.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Authorities have arrested five self-described anarchists in the Cleveland, Ohio, area for allegedly plotting to blow up a four-lane highway bridge over a national park. They were arrested by the FBI after planting the explosives on the bridge.
- ◆ A new study says taser guns used by law enforcement can cause heart rhythm problems, sudden cardiac arrest, and death. The study says users should exercise caution, avoid chest shocks, and monitor the person after tasing him to ensure there are no adverse reactions. It also says taser users need to have adequate medical knowledge to deal with sudden cardiac arrest in people who are stunned.
- ◆ The fastest growth in U.S. manufacturing in 10 months gave stocks a lift Tuesday and lifted the Dow Jones Industrial Average to its highest close in more than four years. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 65.69 at 13,279.32.
- ◆ A Polish dentist is facing three years in prison after she removed all of her ex-boyfriend's teeth during dental surgery just days after their breakup. The man showed up at her dental office complaining of a toothache just days after he broke up with her. She gave him a heavy dose of anesthetic and removed his teeth, one by one.

AUB TO REMOVE A "FEW" TREES IN VETERANS PARK

Work has started on a project that will upgrade wastewater lines that run underground through Veterans Park near downtown Athens. Many of the trees in the park have been marked with an "X" and that has sparked rumors that many of the park's trees will be removed. AUB spokesman Wayne Scarbrough says not every tree with an X will need to be removed. In fact, he says only 5 or 6 trees will have to come down. That will include two maples, one wild cherry, one evergreen, and one or two box elders.

Scarbrough says if the project could be done with zero tree removal, then zero trees would be removed. He says the project involves laying wastewater lines deep in the ground and they cannot be laid without removing trees that are in the way. He also says AUB will work with the City of Athens to replace trees that are removed.
