## Local & State News

### ◆ CAR FLIPS ON HIGHWAY 163

### ◆ JULY 4TH FIREWORKS SHOWS POSTPONED

Due to the extremely dry conditions and the risk of fires, both the cities of Athens and Decatur have decided to postpone their July 4th fireworks shows. The fireworks shows will be rescheduled when conditions improve.

As a result of the drought and heat, the McMinn County Emergency Management Agency urges citizens in the unincorporated areas of the county to use extreme caution while shooting fireworks this Fourth of July. It is illegal to shoot fireworks in Athens.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ The National Weather Service issued extreme heat warnings for 14 states from Georgia to Illinois on Sunday. Athens Utilities Board recorded a high of 104 on Sunday. The dry weather has caused a breakout of forest fires in Polk County, with three active fires burning in the Cherokee National Forest. Officials say heat may be to blame for the deaths of two young boys in Bradley County. The boys, ages 3 and 5, were found unresponsive by their mother after being outside for 45 minutes playing on a slip 'n slide.

◆ States of emergency have been declared in Ohio, Maryland, West Virginia, Virginia, and Washington, D.C., after high winds blew trees down and knocked out electricity to 3-million people.

◆ A Chattanooga man has been killed in the crash of a twin-engine airplane in Dalton, Georgia. Donald Holbrook, 52, crashed shortly after taking off from the Dalton airport. He was the owner of Holbrook Performance Parts.

◆ Hundreds of Japanese protested Sunday as a nuclear power plant restarted. It was the first plant to go back online since Japan shut down all 50 of its nuclear reactors in the wake of last year's massive earthquake and tsunami which sent one nuclear plant into multiple meltdowns.
