State & Local News

◆ INTENSE STORMS PRODUCE HIGH WINDS

A large band of severe thunderstorms moved through East Tennessee last night, producing winds up to 70 m.p.h., knocking down hundreds of trees, and disrupting power. In Meigs County, a propane gas tank was blown into some power lines and became entangled. A small brush fire was reported in the south end of McMinn County, possibly sparked by lightning. Inside Athens, a wind gust of 45 m.p.h. was recorded at Westside School and several trees fell across buildings and homes.

◆ FIRE DESTROYS DECATUR BUILDING

A fire early Thursday morning destroyed Bobbie Sue's on Jones Street in Decatur. The building once housed a factory and more recently featured a flea market and an arcade game center.

◆ Ann Romney says her husband is considering choosing a woman to be his running mate. She told CBS News she has been playing a big role in the VP search.

◆ A judge in Florida has set bond at \$1 million for George Zimmerman, the man charged with second-degree murder in the Feb. 26th shooting of Trayvon Martin. Zimmerman was granted bond in April after posting a \$150,000 bond, but was sent back to jail after prosecutors said he and his wife misled the court about his finances at his initial bond hearing.

◆ An Iranian military commander says his country has detailed contingency plans to strike nearly three dozen U.S. military bases in the region should Iran be attacked. He says the U.S. has 35 bases around Iran that are within the range of Iranian missiles.

◆ Investigators are trying to determine what caused a private yacht to capsize off New York's Long Island Wednesday night. There were 27 people aboard the yacht. They were returning from watching a fireworks display. Three children drowned. Investigators say possible causes were overcrowding, a strong thunderstorm in the area, a mechanical problem, or wakes from other boats. The children's bodies were found in the cabin of the submerged boat.
