◆ **EMT's NOMINATED FOR CONGRESSIONAL MEDAL**
 McMinn County Emergency Medical Technicians Kristi Graham and Freddy Leslie are being nominated for the Congressional Public Safety Officer Medal of Valor. Graham and Leslie were the two American Medical Response EMT's that were some of the first responders on the scene after Tennessee State Trooper Lowell Russell's patrol car was struck by a semi tractor-trailer last March, causing it to burst into flames. Russell was sitting in the vehicle, parked on the side of the Interstate in Knoxville. Trooper Russell was unconscious and at risk of being consumed in the fire when he was rescued by Graham and Leslie. If Graham and Leslie win the medal, it will be presented to them by the president. The recipients of the award will be named sometime next year.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ The State Department was asked twice by a U.S. Security Office, Eric Nordstrom, for more security agents in Benghazi months before an attack that killed the U.S. ambassador to Libya and three other Americans. Officer Nordstrom got no response from the State Department. There will be a House committee hearing on Wednesday. This will be Congress' first public examination of what went wrong at the U.S. diplomatic post in Benghazi.

◆ A survey of likely voters in Ohio, from the local affiliate, NBC4, in Columbus, shows the President and Republican challenger Mitt Romney now statistically tied in Ohio.

◆ Two days after South Korea struck a deal with the United States to extend the range of its ballistic missiles, North Korea said on Tuesday, they have rockets that can hit the U.S. mainland. Since the conflict between North and South Korea in 1950-53 ended in a truce, not a peace treaty, they have been technically at war, and regional powers have been trying to rein in North Korea's nuclear weapons program for years.

◆ If you have doubts about the official jobless rate, check out the "U-6" rate, which is the "real" unemployment rate that measures everybody considered unemployed plus a lot of others who are falling through the cracks. The government's own "U-6" measures unemployment at 14.7 percent.
