### State & Local News

#### ◆ TENNESSEE'S UNEMPLOYMENT DROPS

Unemployment in Tennessee was at 8.3% at the end of September, down from 8.5% in August. Total non-farm employment increased by about 3,300 jobs from August to September.

#### ◆ TENNESSEAN NEWSPAPER DOES A 180

The Nashville newspaper where Vice President Al Gore used to work has done the unthinkable and endorsed a Republican for President. The newspaper's editorial page has endorsed Mitt Romney for president urging him to: "Be the man who governed Massachusetts, and you'll reunite America."

### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ An array of authorities, ranging from police chiefs, prosecutors, pastors and local Boy Scout leaders quietly shielded scoutmasters and others accused of molesting children, a newly opened trove of confidential papers shows. The authorities justified their actions as necessary to protect the good name and good works of Scouting. The secret "perversion files" released Thursday by order of the Oregon Supreme Court, detail the maneuvers that allowed sexual predators to go free while victims suffered in silence.
- ◆ President Obama told "The Daily Show" host Jon Stewart on Thursday that his response regarding the deadly attack in Libya, had not suffered from "confusion," but admitted that communication among government agencies and to the American public was "not optimal" and needs fixing. This response was due to heavy fire from Republicans over the deadly attack in Libya.
- ◆ U.S. health officials confirmed the presence of a deadly fungus in one of three lots of steroids tied to a national meningitis outbreak. The death toll rose to 20 on Thursday.
- ◆ The State Department is offering multi-million dollar rewards for information that leads to the capture of two alleged high-level members of al Qaeda based in Iran.
- ◆ Cristiano Ronaldo, Soccer pro from Portugal, became the first athlete in any sport to reach 50 million "likes" on Facebook.


