## Local and State News

### ◆ NEW \$28 MILLION FACTORY TO BE BUILT

H.P. Pelzer Automotive Systems, Inc. has announced that they will build a new 185,000-square-foot manufacturing facility at the Mt. Verd Industrial Park here in Athens. The company will supply interior products to auto assembly plants in the Southeast. The company hopes to have the building completed by September 15th and plans to hire up to 200 workers. The company is headquartered in Witten, Germany and employs over 5,000 people in 18 countries. The U.S. headquarters is in Troy, Michigan. The picture shows how the new facility will look upon completion.



## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ At least 120 people are injured and three dead after two bombs exploded near the finish line of the Boston Marathon Monday afternoon. The injuries include dismemberment and local hospitals said they treated shrapnel wounds, open fractures and limb injuries. An eight-year-old boy is one of the three known dead, and several of the injured are also children.

◆ The G20 summit will be held in Russia in September this year and President Obama will meet with Russian President Vladimir Putin. Russia is being pressured by The United States to use its influence to help reduce tensions with North Korea.

◆ The Carnival Cruise Ship, Triumph, which was disabled in February due to an engine fire during a cruise in the Gulf of Mexico, cost the U.S. government nearly \$780,000 in its rescue assistance. The cruise line does not plan to reimburse the government for these costs. In response to a letter to Carnival from Senator Jay Rockefeller, Carnival Corp. claims that its policy is to "honor maritime tradition that holds that the duty to render assistance at sea to those in need is a universal obligation of the entire maritime community." Senator Jay Rockefeller called the response "shameful" and is considering "all options to hold the industry to higher passenger safety standards."

### Monday's Market Report

U.S. stocks ended substantially lower after China reported slower GDP growth than expected. The slowdown in China led to broad weakness in the market, as all S&P industries finished in negative territory and commodities dropped to their lowest levels since last July. U.S. Treasury prices finished higher on the weakness in equities and following comments by Fed officials in regards to the continuation of its bond purchasing. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 265.86 at 14,599.20. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 36.49 at 1,552.36, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 78.46 at 3,216.49.

**COMMODITY MARKETS:** The spot price of gold fell \$126.16 to \$1,356.85. The spot price of silver fell \$3.08 to \$22.94, and crude oil prices fell \$3.27 to \$88.02.
