### ◆ McMinn Rugby Teams Win State Title

## World & National News

◆ A report written by the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration details missteps the IRS took in targeting certain political groups for additional scrutiny. The report says lax management allowed the practice to go on for 18 months. An audit confirmed previous reports that the IRS flagged applications from organizations that used words like "tea party" and "patriots" in their title. The IRS apologized for targeting Tea Party as well as other conservative groups.

◆ Donald Trump who is accused of wooing investors into buying condos at his namesake Chicago skyscraper took the witness stand Tuesday at a civil trial. Trump is accused of reneging on a profit-sharing promise.

◆ Two of the women that were imprisoned in a Cleveland, Ohio house, Gina DeJesus and Michelle Knight, suffered from severe malnutrition and will require long-term therapy for injuries such as hearing loss and joint and muscle damage. The conditions of their imprisonment were described as similar to a prisoner of war camp.

◆ On Sunday, it was 32 degrees in Omaha, Nebraska. On Tuesday, it was 100 degrees. The state set new high and low temperature records in the course of just 72 hours.

## Today In History - May 16

**1770** - Marie Antoinette, age 14, married the future King Louis XVI of France, who was 15.

**1831** - David Hughes, the inventor of the microphone, was born.

**1868** - The U.S. Senate failed by one vote to convict President Andrew Johnson as it took its first ballot on one of 11 articles of impeachment against him. (He was acquitted of all charges.)

**1929** - The first Academy Award movie awards were given. They did not become known as "Oscars" until 1931 after a secretary commented that the statuettes given to the performers resembled her Uncle Oscar.

**2001** - Former FBI agent Robert Hanssen was indicted on charges of spying for Moscow. He later pleaded guilty to 15 counts of espionage and was sentenced to life in prison without parole.

**2002** - The remains of kidnapped Wall Street Journal reporter Daniel Pearl were unearthed in Pakistan.
