### Local and State News

#### ◆ FEDS SEIZE DOCTOR'S BANK ACCOUNTS

Federal authorities have sized almost \$7 million from bank accounts of a Cleveland physician, Dr. Raymond Sean Brown. A lawsuit filed in federal court accuses him of submitting false medicare claims. Over \$6.5 million was seized from Dr. Brown's account at Athens Federal Community Bank and \$186-thousand from his account with the Tennessee Valley Federal Credit Union.

### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A massive tornado about a mile wide has torn through Oklahoma, flattening homes and schools and causing widespread destruction in the Oklahoma City area. Videos of the twister show a giant funnel cloud powering across the landscape.
- ◆ Fox News has angrily denounced the Justice Department's "downright chilling" decision to target of one of its reporters, James Rosen, in a national security leak investigation. Executive Vice President Michael Clemente portrayed the government's actions as an assault on "what up until now has always been a free press."
- ◆ The Associated Press' president and chief executive, Gary Pruitt, says the government's secret seizure of two months of reporters' phone records has already had a chilling effect on newsgathering. Pruitt called the Justice Department's actions "unconstitutional" and said the AP hasn't ruled out legal action.
- ◆ United Airlines has resumed flying the Boeing 787 after they were grounded for four months because of smoldering batteries on 787s owned by other airlines. The incidents included an emergency landing of one plane, and a fire on another. Federal authorities lifted the grounding order on April 19 but it has taken Boeing, which makes the plane, and the airlines a few more weeks to fix them.

**1688** - English poet Alexander Pope was born. He wrote these oft-quoted lines: "To err is human, to forgive, divine."

**1819** - The first bicycles in the United States were called swift walkers and were seen for the first time on the streets of New York City on this day.

**1878** - Inventor Glenn Curtiss was born. After proving that airplanes could land and take off from ships, he built the first U.S. Navy planes.

**1881** - The first American Red Cross chapter was organized in Washington, D.C., by Clara Barton.

**1927** - Charles Lindbergh landed his plane, "The Spirit of St. Louis," in Paris after completing the first solo flight across the Atlantic.
