Local and State News

◆ COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE:

- ✓ The Good Faith Clinic will conduct a health fair in cooperation with the James H. Quillen College of Medicine, East Tennessee State University, this Thursday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Good Faith Clinic located at 18 South Congress Parkway in Athens. The fair will provide an opportunity for uninsured adults 18 and older in McMinn and Meigs Counties to receive physical exams and medical tests that they could not afford otherwise. Exams will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. The exams will be performed by medical students from East Tennessee State University, supervised by licensed physicians. You do not have to be a patient of the Good Faith Clinic to receive the physical examinations, but you must meet the eligibility requirements.
- ✓ The Niota Depot Celebrity Golf Classic will be Saturday, June 8th beginning at 1:00 p.m. There will also be a yard sale at the Niota Depot on June 7th and 8th from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Proceeds go to restore the oldest standing depot in the state of Tennessee. NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Tanya Kach, a 31-year-old Pittsburgh woman who was kidnapped in 1996 at the age of 14, finally got to attend her senior prom. The Second Chance Prom for people over 21 was held over the weekend and Kach attended the prom with her fiancé. She was held in the basement of Thomas Hose, a janitor at her school, for 10 years, until her rescue in 2006.
- ◆ Larry Goodwin, 62, of Moody, Texas was attacked and killed on Saturday by a huge swarm of Africanized killer bees. Goodwin suffered more than 3,000 stings and collapsed while trying to reach a hydrant to wash off the bees. The ambulance crew that first arrived refused to help him saying it wasn't safe to approach him because the bees are so aggressive.
- ◆ Pfc. Bradley Manning, who is accused of leaking hundreds of thousands of classified documents to the anti-secrecy website WikiLeaks, went on trial Monday. Manning, who is a former intelligence analyst from Oklahoma, has admitted to giving troves of information to WikiLeaks in the biggest leak of classified information in U.S. history.
- ◆ Boston's fire chief, Steve Abaira resigned Monday, saying public criticism from his deputies for the way he responded to the marathon bombings has made it impossible for him to do his job.

Tennessee Headlines

- ✓ A Morristown woman has been charged with TennCare fraud. Jacqueline N. McCravey, 26, has been charged in an indictment that says she took a forged prescription for the painkiller Lortab to a Hamblen County pharmacy. TennCare fraud is a Class E felony carrying a sentence of up to two years in prison.
- ✓ The President has signed into law a bill blocking the Army Corps of Engineers from erecting barriers to prevent fishing in the tailwaters of several dams. The measure preserves access to fishing below dams on the Cumberland River in Kentucky and Tennessee.
- ✓ A 17-year-old boy is in big trouble times two. He was walking through a residential area in Knoxville, when a loaded .45 caliber handgun accidentally discharged and struck him in the leg. It turns out that the weapon was stolen. Knoxville police say the teenager will be charged with possessing a stolen weapon.

MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT: The Dow Jones Industrial Average, which has gained for six months in a row, kept its winning streak going Monday. The blue chip index was up all day but the buying really gained steam into the close, sending the Dow up 138 points, or 0.9%. It's been a stellar year for stocks so far. All three indexes are up between 14% and 16%. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 138.46 points, closing at 15,254.0. The NASDAQ Composite Index was up 9.46, closing at 3,465.37. The Standard and Poors 500 Index was up 9.68, closing at 1,640.42.

TODAY IN HISTORY - June 4

- 1896** - Auto-maker Henry Ford pulled his first car out of a brick shed in Detroit and drove it around the city's darkened streets on a trial run. The car had one seat, bicycle wheels, and an electric bell. It is now on display in Michigan...and it still runs!
- 1942** - The Battle of Midway began on this date during World War II. The Japanese Navy suffered its first decisive defeat in the battle. The United States was well prepared because Japan's secret codes had been cracked and the attack plans were discovered.
- 1944** - Singer Michelle Phillips of the Mamas and Papas was born. The group's big hits included "Monday, Monday" and "Dedicated to the One I Love."
- 1985** The Supreme Court upheld a lower court ruling striking down an Alabama law providing for a daily minute of silence in public schools.
- 1998** - A federal judge sentenced Terry Nichols to live in prison for his role in the Oklahoma City bombing.
