- ✓ University of Alabama Head Football Coach Nick Saban will be in Athens this evening to speak to the 7th Annual Athens Chamber of Commerce Benefit Dinner. The event begins with dinner at 6 p.m. and the program begins at 7 p.m. The event will be held under the big tent erected on the field at Tennessee Wesleyan College on Green Street.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The Director of National Intelligence, James Clapper, is really struggling to explain why he told Congress in March that the National Security Agency does not intentionally collect any kind of data on millions of Americans. Clapper stated that they did not collect data unwittingly but could inadvertently collect data. Clapper said that it was an unfair question and equated it to, when are you going to stop beating your wife kind of question, and that it depended on the meaning of "collect."
- ◆ Senator Bob Corker of Tennessee, the top Republican on the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, pressed President Obama to arm moderate Syrian rebels friendly to the United States "at the earliest possible time."
- ◆ Court records alleged years of turmoil between the parents of John Zawahri, the young man who fatally shot five people in Santa Monica, California, last week. Zawahri's mother described her husband as "verbally abusive and controlling" during their marriage. Zawahri fatally shot his father, brother and three other victims on Friday.
- ◆ On the first day of George Zimmerman's trial, he got a look at the people who might decide whether he committed second-degree murder when he fatally shot 17-year-old Trayvon Martin. Both the prosecution and defense want jurors who they believe can be objective in the highly publicized case. The judge will keep the identities of the selected jurors anonymous but rejected a defense request to sequester the entire jury pool of 500 residents.

MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks finished the day mixed after fluctuating between gains and losses on diverse economic data. On the positive side, Standard & Poor's increased the United States' AA+ credit rating to stable from negative, and Japan posted its strongest quarterly GDP increase in two years. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 9.53 at 15,238.59. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 0.57 at 1,642.81, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 4.55 at 3,473.77. Volume on the New York Stock Exchange was low, with 554.20 million shares traded.

1864 - German composer Richard Strauss was born.

1880 - The first female member of the U.S. Congress, Jeannette Rankin, was born in Montana. She created a furor by becoming the only member of Congress to vote against a declaration of war on Japan following the attack on Pearl Harbor.

1910 - Undersea explorer Jacques Cousteau was born.

1913 - Football coach Vince Lombardi was born. He was head coach of the Green Bay Packers from 1959 until, 1969. Under his leadership, the Packers won two Super Bowl games. Lombardi's record at Green Bay was 141 wins, 39 losses, and 4 ties.

1927 - Aviator Charles Lindbergh was welcomed home by President Calvin Coolidge after making history's first non-stop flight across the Atlantic Ocean, to Paris.
