## Local & State News

### ◆ ANDERSON ARRESTED ON THEFT, MISCONDUCT

McMinn County Property Assessor, Jerry Anderson, was arrested yesterday afternoon after being indicted by the McMinn County Grand Jury and charged with two counts of theft of property under \$500 and for official misconduct. ### ◆ STATE TO OPERATE SMOKY MTN NATIONAL PARK

Governor Haslam announced late Tuesday that the State of Tennessee will open and operate the Smoky National National Park beginning today through Sunday, October 20th, at a cost of \$60,000 per day. Legislation proposed in the U.S. House and U.S. Senate on Tuesday will reimburse the state, when the government shut-down is over and the federal government its normal operation.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown, Connecticut, the site of one of America's worst school shootings, is being torn down and workers have been required by the town to sign confidentiality agreements barring them from discussing or photographing the site. A grant of nearly \$50 million to demolish the school and build a new one was accepted by the town last month. Demolition is expected to be completed by December 14 of this year.

◆ William D. Swenson, a former Army captain, received the nation's highest military award, the Medal of Honor, from President Obama at the White House on Tuesday. Swenson's heroic actions in a deadly Afghan battle were captured on video.

◆ Iranian negotiators have put forward a potential breakthrough plan at the long-stalled talks on easing fears that Tehran wants atomic weapons. Iran declared that they no longer want to walk in the dark of international isolation.

◆ Two Florida girls were arrested after one of them acknowledged the harassing a young girl online. The girls were primarily responsible for bullying a 12-year-old girl who later killed herself.

◆ Bob Filner, former San Diego Mayor driven pleaded guilty Tuesday to a felony for putting a woman in a headlock and to lesser counts for kissing one woman and grabbing the buttocks of another.

### Deputy's Wife Arrested for Drugs

The TBI arrested Marquita Price (pictured below), age 29, of Niota, on Tuesday and charged her with one count of theft over \$1000, one count of possession of a schedule I drug for resale, and two counts of possession of schedule II drugs for resale. Price was indicted by the McMinn County Grand Jury on Tuesday after she was accused of taking drugs from the safe of her husband, Deputy Jared Price's patrol car, sometime between October 2012 and December 2012. Missing were 20 grams of cocaine, 9 grams of meth, and 10 grams of heroin from evidence bags. The drugs were stored in the vehicle and were used as training tools for the sheriff's office K-9 program. McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy and District Attorney Steven Bebb requested that the TBI conduct an investigation into the missing drugs. Price was booked into the McMinn County Jail on \$50,000 bond. Deputy Price was cleared of any wrongdoing in the case.
