Local and State News

◆ FIRE HITS TRAILER ON HIGHWAY 39

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A federal judge has ruled that new Texas abortion restrictions violate the U.S. Constitution, leaving open, at least for now, dozens of abortion clinics that were set to close today.
- ◆ Penn State has announced it is paying nearly \$60 million to 26 young men to settle claims of child sexual abuse at the hands of former assistant football coach Jerry Sandusky.
- ◆ Detroit's emergency city manager says the city is in such dire financial straits that bumpers are falling off police cars. He says a bankruptcy filing is the only way back to health.
- ◆ The S&P 500 closed at another record high Monday, up 2.34 at 1,762.11. The Dow Jones industrial average closed down 1.35 at 15,568.93. Oil closed down 5 cents at 98.64.

DEPUTIES CATCH BURGLAR

McMinn County Sheriff's deputies caught a burglary suspect last Friday afternoon after he tried to break into an occupied residence. A young female at the residence on Wilkins Drive off Highway 39E called 911 to say that two men were trying to break into her home. She set off a panic alarm, which caused one suspect to flee on foot and the other to drive away in an SUV. Deputy Dale Murray spotted the SUV on Highway 39 and managed to force it off the road on County Road 550. The driver, 42-year-old Robert Eaves of Englewood, was treated for minor injuries and then booked into the jail on several charges including burglary, theft, evading arrest, and DUI. Items from other burglaries were found in the SUV. Deputies are looking for the second suspect.

TODAY IN HISTORY-OCTOBER 29

1618 - Sir Walter Raleigh was executed in London. He had been charged with participating in a plot to oust King James the First from the British throne. Sir Walter was one of the colonizers of North America. According to legend, he once pulled off his cloak and placed it over a puddle to protect the feet of the passing queen.

1901 - Leon Czolgosz was electrocuted for the assassination of President William McKinley.

1904 - Fingerprinting was used for the first time by the St. Louis police department.

1927 - Pan American World Airways (Pan Am) flew the first international flight — from Key West, Florida to Havana, Cuba.

1929 - The New York Stock Exchange crashed. Several stockbrokers jumped to their death from their office windows in reaction. The crash led to the Great Depression.

1937 - Bluegrass singer Sonny Osborne was born. He and his brother had the biggest hit recording of "Rocky Top."
