## Local and State News

### ◆ HOSPITALS TO CONDUCT CASUALTY DRILL

One of the largest hospital exercises ever in the state of Tennessee will take place in East Tennessee tomorrow. Athens Regional Medical Center and Woods Memorial Hospital will be among the 56 hospitals, health departments, first responders and other agencies along with some 1,000 victim actors participating in the exercise. The Mass Casualty Exercise will test the region's hospitals' plans for coping with mass casualty incidents and communication capabilities. The event will be treated as though it were real, with victim actors to arrive at both the Athens and Woods hospitals tomorrow morning.

### ◆ DAVIS IS FINALIST FOR LEADERSHIP AWARD

Athens City Council member Ann Davis is one of three finalists for the 2013 Women in Municipal Government Leadership Award. The award recognizes a female local government official for unique and outstanding leadership. The winner is recognized for initiating creative and successful programs and for serving as a mentoring model for future female leaders. The winner will be announced on November 15th at the National League of Cities' Congress of Cities and Exposition in Seattle, Washington.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ U.S. Senator Bob Corker of Tennessee has announced he is a cosponsor of the "If You Like Your Health Care Plan You Can Keep It Act." The bill, introduced by Senator Ron Johnson of Wisconsin and cosponsored by 37 Republican senators, would provide relief from Obamacare standards for current health insurance policies, giving Americans the freedom to keep their current health care plans if they so choose. Senator Corker says a Tennessee couple contacted him last week to tell him the policy they've had for five years as self-employed missionaries is being cancelled because it doesn't meet the standards of Obamacare. He says they face the stress of losing their health coverage in January despite failed efforts to enroll in a new plan on the federal exchange.

◆ The Central Connecticut State University campus was locked down for more than three hours Monday after reports that a person carrying a sword and gun was spotted at the school. An "all clear" was given by mid-afternoon and three people were in custody. Police said they were investigating the possibility it was a Halloween hoax.

◆ **The Athens City Council**, meeting in a called session Monday evening, has voted to participate in the "Rails to Trails" program. The measure passed with a 3 to 2 vote. Voting against the proposal was Dick Pelley and Chuck Burris. Voting for the proposal was Mayor Hal Buttram, Bo Perkinson, & Ann Davis.
