◆ FIRE DESTROYS COUNTY ROAD 685 HOUSE

National & International News

◆ Prince Charles will be 65 on Thursday, which is the usual retirement age for British workers, but he's still waiting to take up the job he has been destined for since birth. Prince Charles, the eldest son of Britain's Queen Elizabeth II has been heir to the throne for more than 60 years.

◆ A propane gas tank rigged up as a homemade bomb exploded in flames outside a courthouse in the southwestern Oregon town of Medford just before dawn on Wednesday. Officers were called to the Jackson County courthouse at about 4:30 a.m. (PST) to investigate reports of an explosion. They discovered a damaged seven-gallon propane tank which was ablaze, as well as broken glass from shattered windows. They believe the suspect tried to detonate the propane tank with an improvised explosive device which only damaged the propane tank.

◆ Federal prosecutors called convicted mobster James "Whitey" Bulger a "sociopath" who reigned brutally over Boston in the 1970s and '80s, and asked a judge to send the aging former crime boss to prison for the rest of his life. Bulger was convicted in August of murdering 11 people following a two-month trial rife with bloody tales of gun-toting mobsters mowing down rivals and unlucky bystanders.

An Athens couple are helping to get food to victims of the typhoon in the Philippines. Larry and Bobbie Womack are missionaries who lead The Hope Foundation, which provides hot meals, medical help, and Bible teaching in the Philippines. They live in Tacloban, which was the city hit hardest by the typhoon. Larry Womack says he survived the typhoon by climbing onto a beam in the roof of their beachside home. Bobbie Womack says relief supplies are trickling into Tacloban very slowly. She says it is a massive undertaking to try to feed a city of over 150,000 people.

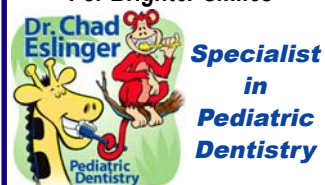

1765 - Robert Fulton, the steamboat inventor, was born.

1832 - The first horse-drawn street car made its appearance in New York City. It carried 30 passengers.

1891 - Canadian physician Sir Frederick Banting was born. He was the primary discoverer of insulin, which has greatly aided the treatment of people with diabetes.

1970 - Seventy-five people were killed when their chartered plane crashed at Tri-State Airport in West Virginia. The plane was returning from a football game at Greenville, North Carolina. Forty-three of those killed were Marshall University football players and coaches. The crash and the aftermath were told in the movie, "We Are Marshall."

1982 - The Vietnam Veterans Memorial was dedicated in Washington, D.C.
