### National & International News

- ◆ President Obama honored 16 prominent Americans with the Presidential Medal of Freedom which is the highest award the U.S. gives a civilian. The ceremony opened a day of tributes to former President John F. Kennedy, who established the modern version of the medal. Kennedy was assassinated 50 years ago, on November 22, 1963.
- ◆ According to a new federal policy, overweight U.S. pilots and air traffic controllers will soon need to be screened for sleep apnea. The Federal Aviation Administration's chief medical officer told physicians in a recent memo that they will shortly be required to calculate the body mass index (BMI) of pilots and controllers. The ones with a BMI of 40 or more must be evaluated by a sleep specialist.
- ◆ After arbitrator Fredric Horowitz refused to order baseball Commissioner Bud Selig to testify, baseball star Alex Rodriguez walked out of his grievance hearing yesterday. A grievance was filed by the players' association to overturn the 211-game suspension given to Rodriguez by Major League Baseball last summer for alleged violations of the sport's drug agreement and labor contract. Rodriguez said he was disgusted with the abusive process which he believes is designed to ensure that the player fails.
