NATIONAL AND WORLD NEWS

◆ Target Corp's chief financial officer will testify before the U.S. Senate Judiciary Committee on February 4 about the massive data breach that Target experienced. Target is based in Minneapolis, and says that a breach of its networks resulted in the theft of about 40 million credit and debit card records and 70 million other records with customer information.

◆ National Security Agency leaker Edward Snowden, wants to return to the United States, but believes he would not be able to get a fair trial because current whistle-blower protection laws do not cover NSA contractors.

◆ According to a video posted on You Tube, a naked protester was assaulted and humiliated by a member of Ukraine's elite Bekrut riot police force after he was detained in freezing cold temperatures in Kiev. The man had apparently been arrested during the clashes between police and protesters. The video, shows the arrested protester completely naked except for his socks and being roughly pushed into a police bus.

◆ Federal prosecutors have subpoenaed Governor Chris Christie's re-election campaign and the state Republican leadership due to criminal investigations into allegations that the governor's aides created traffic jams as political payback. They are looking for documents related to the closure of traffic lanes near the George Washington Bridge.
