NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The House Republican conference voted to promote Kevin McCarthy of California as majority leader to replace Eric Cantor who was defeated in last Tuesday's Virginia primary by David Brat.
- ◆ Local and federal authorities have scaled back a three-week search for a missing Alaska couple and their two small children who were last heard from in late May, police said. Rebecca Adams, 22, her two daughters aged 5 and 3, and her 37-year-old boyfriend Brandon Jividen were reported missing on May 27th.
- ◆ The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention in Atlanta says some of its staff may have been accidentally been exposed to dangerous anthrax bacteria because of a safety problem at one of its labs.
- ◆ Senator Bob Corker of Tennessee is co-sponsor of a bill that would raise the federal gasoline tax by 12 cents over the next two years to help pay the cost of road repairs. To offset the additional cost to consumers, the bill provides for tax reductions for families and businesses.
- ◆ What started as a routine response for a Maine tow truck driver ended with a trip to the hospital after he was swarmed by thousands of honeybees.
- ◆ Harley-Davidson has introduced its first electric motorcycle, a sleek, futuristic bike that sounds like a jet airplane taking off and can go from 0 to 60 mph in less than four seconds.
