## WORLD & NATIONAL NEWS

◆ Retired Marine Corps General John Allen told ABC News in an exclusive interview that the ISIS video appearing to show a Jordanian pilot being burned alive "absolutely" backfired on the terror group. Allen met with Jordanian King Abdullah who ordered numerous airstrikes against the Islamic terrorists. Estimates of over a thousand ISIS supporters have now been killed.

◆ Police say that Olympic gold medalist Bruce Jenner did not appear to be attempting to evade the paparazzi before he was involved in a chain-reaction crash in Malibu, California, that killed one person. Jenner was uninjured.

◆ Five people were killed and two more injured in a shooting just west of Atlanta in Douglasville, Ga. on Saturday evening. Police called the scene "gruesome." The ages of those killed in the shooting ranged from seven to adult. The shooter's motive was not immediately clear.

◆ Former University of North Carolina men's basketball coach Dean Smith has died. He was 83 years old. Smith was the head coach of the Tar Heels for 36 seasons and retired with the best Division I men's college basketball coaching record in history - 879-254.

**1914** - Country singer Ernest Tubbs was born. His signature song was "I'm Walking The Floor Over You."

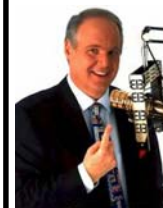
**1950** - Wisconsin Senator Joseph McCarthy charged that the U.S. State Department was full of communists.
