◆ Deputy Robert Bates, a 73-year-old volunteer reserve deputy in Oklahoma, is accused of fatally shooting a suspect after he allegedly mistook his own handgun for a stun-gun. Bates has been charged with second-degree manslaughter in the fatal shooting of Eric Harris.

◆ Jodi Arias was sentenced to life in prison with no possibility of parole on Monday after she was found guilty in May 2013 of murdering her on again-off again boyfriend, Travis Alexander, five years earlier.

Decliners outnumbered advancers by roughly a 3-to-2 margin. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 80.61 at 17,977.04. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 9.63 at 2,092.43, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 7.73 at 4,988.25.

TODAY IN HISTORY - April 14

- 1775** - The first American society for the abolition of slavery was formed in Philadelphia.
- 1828** - Noah Webster copyrighted the first edition of his dictionary.
- 1861** - The flag of the Confederate States of America was raised over Fort Sumter, South Carolina, as the Union troops posted there surrendered in the early days of the Civil War.
- 1865** - John Wilkes Booth crept into President Abraham Lincoln's box at Ford Theater in Washington and shot Mr. Lincoln. The President died the next morning.
- 1910** - President William Howard Taft became the first U.S. chief executive to throw the ceremonial first pitch at a baseball game as the Washington Senators beat the Philadelphia Athletics 3-0.
- 1935** - Country singer Loretta Lynn was born in Butcher Holler, Kentucky...a coal miner's daughter. She was one of eight children. She married at the age of 14 and eventually moved to Nashville. Her first top ten hit record was "Success" in 1962.
