◆ **CORKER ON LIST OF 100 INFLUENTIAL PEOPLE**

U.S. Senator Bob Corker of Tennessee is on TIME Magazine's list of the 100 Most Influential People in the World. Corker is chairman of the powerful Senate Foreign Relations Committee. Others on the list include President Obama, Pope Francis, Jeb Bush, Hillary Clinton, Vladimir Putin, Kim Kardashian, Tim McGraw, Benjamin Netanyahu, and Taylor Swift. Senator Corker says he is humbled by this honor. He says he wakes up every day trying to find ways to move our country ahead. Corker is a former mayor of Chattanooga. The tribute to Corker in TIME was written by Tennessee's Senior Senator, Lamar Alexander. Alexander says if he is not President some day himself, Corker is an obvious choice for Secretary of State or Treasury.

The Bible will not become the official Tennessee state book. The Senate voted 22 to 9 to kill the Bible bill, a day after it was passed by the House. The Senate agreed to send the bill back to a committee, and that effectively kills it for this year.
