Local & State News

◆ TIME TO "WET A LINE!"

The Athens Parks and Recreation Department's 17th annual free Kids Fishing Derby will be held this coming Saturday, April 25, from 8 to 11:30 a.m. at the Athens Regional Park. There will be over \$2,000 in prizes, including two tagged trout worth \$500 and \$250. A free lunch will be provided to all participants. The fishing derby is for boys and girls ages 12 and under. Participants do not need a fishing license, but must bring their own rod and reel. All participants must register on site and be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Registration begins at 7 a.m. and fishing will be from 8 until 11:30 a.m. The TWRA will stock the lake with over 800 rainbow trout before the derby, and the lake will be posted closed for public fishing once stocked. Anyone fishing in disregard of those postings will be subject to a fine up to \$500. Tagged fish must be caught by a registered contestant during the derby to be eligible for prizes.

NATIONAL AND WORLD NEWS

◆ Trader Joe's is recalling its sweet apple chicken sausage that could contain dangerous bits of plastic. Affected products have been removed from store shelves and destroyed.

◆ A U.K. futures trader, Navinder Singh Sarao, was charged on Tuesday with stock market manipulation linked to the May 6, 2010 flash crash that saw the Dow Jones Industrial Average fall 1,000 points and the market drop by nine percent in just minutes. Sarao used a "layering algorithm," and made multiple large-scale sell orders that caused the market to sell off, but then cancelled all of his orders before they were ever processed.

◆ NEWS FROM THE STATE LEGISLATURE

✓ Both the Tennessee House and Senate have approved a bill to repeal the Common Core education standards. Governor Haslam says he plans to sign the measure into law. The bill was sponsored by Sen. Mike Bell of Riceville. The bill changes Common Core's name and includes a review process for education standards in Tennessee schools, with a new 10-member commission to oversee the standards.

✓ Legislation that requires all of Tennessee's law enforcement agencies to adopt written policies to ban racial profiling is headed to the governor for his signature. Supporters say the legislation is in response to a series of incidents involving white police officers killing unarmed black men over the last year.

✓ Both the House and Senate have now passed a bill requiring an on-line registry of people who are convicted of cruelty to animals or involved in animal fighting.
