**1851** - Inventor Isaac Singer patented his sewing machine. He made \$13 million in his sewing machine business.

**1985** - A crippled Japan Air Lines Boeing 747 on a domestic flight crashed into a mountain, killing 520 people in the world's worst single-aircraft accident.
