#### ◆ FIRE DESTROYS MASHBURN PARTY BARN

A fire at the Mashburn Lake Event Center on County Road 50 Monday night destroyed the party barn. The barn, pictured below, had been the scene of many weddings, corporate gatherings, and special events over the years. No word on the cause of the fire.



#### ◆ ATHENS POLICE/FIRE REPORT FOR JULY

The Athens City Council members heard the police and fire department reports on July activity at their monthly meeting Tuesday evening.

Police Chief Chuck Ziegler reported 58 thefts, 24 burglaries, 20 assaults, 13 motor vehicle thefts, and two sex offenses in July. Police officers wrote 385 citations for moving violations. There were 68 traffic accidents with a total of 12 injuries.

Fire Chief Jim Dyer reported that firefighters responded to 79 calls in July. One was to a residential fire, two were trash fires, 15 were to vehicle accidents, and 34 were false alarms. It's very unusual, but Chief Dyer says for the month of July, losses from fires totaled zero.

The Tennessee Highway Patrol says one person was killed Monday night when a truck ran off the road and landed in the median on I-75 northbound near mile marker 56 in McMinn County. Troopers say a passenger was killed and the driver was injured. The names have not been released.
