LOCAL & STATE NEWS

◆ **MOTORCYCLE WRECK KILLS ATHENS MAN**
Charles J. Miller, age 36, of Athens, died early Sunday morning. Miller was riding a 2006 Yamaha motorcycle around 1:21 a.m. southbound on County Road 180 and crossed the center line and struck a guardrail on the opposite side of the road. He was thrown from the motorcycle and over the guardrail and down a steep embankment. State Trooper Nathan Hall's report indicated that he died at the scene. This was the second fatal motorcycle crash in McMinn County so far this month. On August 7th, 48 year-old Jeffrey M. Blair of Riceville was killed on State Highway 39 west, the old Riceville Road, when he lost control of his motorcycle.

◆ **CLEVELAND POLICEMAN CAUGHT SEXTING**

More problems have surfaced at the Cleveland Police Department after a shift sergeant abruptly resigned last week. A female officer complained to her supervisor that Sgt. Eddie Bonnett (in photo) sent a nude photo of himself from his personal cell phone to hers. Bonnett will be on unpaid leave until his resignation becomes effective on Aug. 29th.



◆ **McMINN MAN CHARGED IN SHOOTING**

Elishama Howard has been charged with two counts of attempted first degree murder and one count of reckless endangerment after shooting at two teenagers in a car on County Road 802. Howard claims he mistook the teenagers for a person he had an argument with earlier. He was booked into the McMinn County jail under a \$200,000 bond.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Three Americans, two of them service members, helped foil a potentially deadly attack when they subdued an attacker on board a high-speed train bound for Paris. Spencer Stone, Alek Skarlatos, and Anthony Sadler were traveling from Amsterdam to Paris when a man armed with an automatic rifle and a box cutter started attacking passengers. Sadler, 23, an Air Force airman first class stationed in Portugal, and Skarlatos, 23, an Army National Guard specialist stationed in Afghanistan, were visiting Stone, who almost had a finger severed by the attacker's boxcutter.

◆ Vice President Joe Biden cut his vacation short and met privately with Massachusetts Sen. Elizabeth Warren in Washington, D.C., Sunday, in what appears to be a strong indication of how seriously he is mulling a 2016 bid.

◆ In England, a Saturday morning air show turned deadly after a plane crashed onto a nearby roadway. At least 7 people are dead after a jet plane taking part in the Shoreham Airshow crashed into cars parked on a roadway near the Shoreham Airport.

◆ In what was hyped to be one of the biggest events of the 2016 campaign so far, GOP front-runner Donald Trump held a rally Friday night in Mobile, Alabama in front of 30,000 people. The campaign had to switch locations twice to accommodate ticket demands.

- 79 A.D. - Mount Vesuvius erupted, burying the Roman cities of Pompeii and Herculaneum in volcanic ash. An estimated 20,000 people died.
- 1814 - British forces captured Washington, D.C., and burned the White House and the Capitol Building.
- 1875 - Captain Matthew Webb of England set out on the first swim across the English Channel. The distance is only 21 miles as the crow flies. However, because of the tide Webb actually swam nearly twice that distance and was in the water for nearly 22 hours.
- 1932 - Amelia Earhart became the first woman to fly nonstop across the United States, traveling from Los Angeles to Newark, N.J., in just over 19 hours.
