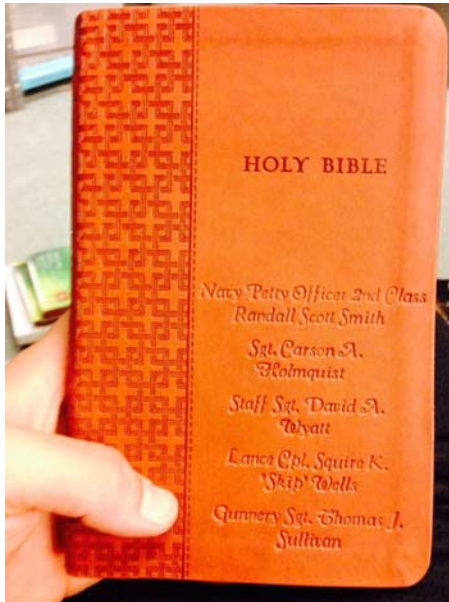

**1949** - The U.S. nuclear monopoly ended as the Soviet Union detonated its first atomic bomb.

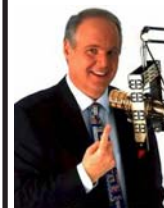
**1956** - Singer Debby Boone was born. Her biggest hit record was "You Light Up My Life."
