## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ A JetBlue flight attendant who was charged with attempting to smuggle nearly 70 pounds of cocaine in her suitcase at Los Angeles International Airport has been granted \$500,000 bail. Marsha Reynolds, 31, of Queens, New York, claims she didn't know what was in her bag.

◆ A United Airlines pilot has been arrested at his Houston home for allegedly running a "prostitution enterprise" in Texas. Bruce Wayne Wallis, 51, was charged with aggravated promotion of prostitution and engaging in organized criminal activity. United Airlines has removed Wallis from flight duty.

◆ Authorities believe they have identified the mystery man wearing the light-colored jacket in a photograph with two of the bombers at the Brussels airport. The name was not released, but it was already in U.S. terrorism databases at the time of the bombings.

◆ It's no surprise that a pair of brothers was among the suspects believed to have carried out the deadly attacks in Brussels. Sets of brothers were involved in Paris, the Charlie Hebdo mass murder in Paris, the Boston Marathon, and the September 11 attacks, where three sets of brothers were among the group of hijackers.
