### ◆ FIRE HITS WARD TREE SERVICE

- ◆ A 4-year-old girl who went missing from her Lakeland, Florida home Saturday morning has been found safe in Memphis, Tennessee. The girl was apparently abducted by 31-year-old West Wild Hogs, formerly named Matthew Clark Pybus. Hogs is his current legal name.
- ◆ At least 20 people in the U.S. have died in the wake of Hurricane Matthew, which battered the East Coast this weekend.
- ◆ In Salisbury, N.C., a 2-year-old girl died after she was left in a hot car with the windows rolled up while her mother went to work at a VA medical clinic. She was left in the car for nearly nine hours.
- ◆ Hillary Clinton and Donald Trump faced off Sunday night in the second presidential debate and made charges about each other's records while defending their own characters and careers.
