◆ BOTH WATTS BAR REACTORS NOW ON LINE

The Watts Bar Nuclear Plant's Unit 2 reactor has become the first nuclear reactor to join the U.S. power grid in the 21st Century. The unit is now supplying electricity for more than 650,000 homes. It took more than nine years to complete the \$4.7 Billion reactor.
