◆ ATHENS DOWNTOWN TO GET MAKE-OVER

Thanks to its participation in the Tennessee Main Street program, the City of Athens has been awarded a \$100,000 grant for Commercial Façade Improvement. The state grant can be used for improvements including new awnings and signs, painting, windows and doors, brick repair, and other upgrades.

◆ FOOD CITY HEARING SET FOR TODAY

A joint public hearing with the McMinn County Commission, the City of Athens, and the Industrial Development Board of McMinn County will be held at 6 p.m. Monday in the Blue Room of the Courthouse. The purpose is to discuss the Food City application for Tax Increment Financing in connection with their plans to open a supermarket in Athens.
