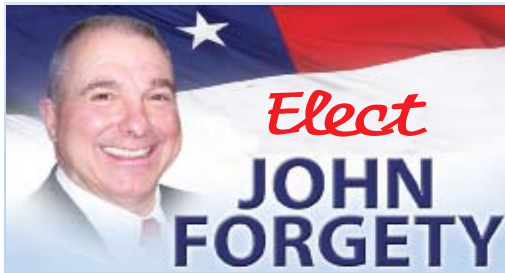

Longest Held POW To Speak

Former Vietnam POW Captain William A. Robinson (USAF Ret.) will share his story this Thursday during a Salute to Veterans Service at Allen Memorial United Methodist Church on Decatur Pike in Athens. The service starts at 6:30 p.m. Captain Robinson will describe what started out as a typical mission day in Vietnam on September 28th, 1965, and turned into a long nightmare when his helicopter was shot down and the entire crew was captured. Robinson was held for seven years and five months, longer than any POW in U.S. military history. The public is encouraged to attend the special Service.
