◆ ATHENS VOTERS CHOOSE COUNCIL MEMBERS

Five candidates were seeking the two open seats on the Athens City Council in Tuesday's election. Voters chose incumbent Chuck Burris (in top photo) with 2344 votes and newcomer John Coker (in bottom photo) with 1973 votes. Coker will be replacing Athens Mayor Ann Davis who chose not to run for re-election. Whitney Kimball Coe received 1592 votes, Timothy M. Hughes got 1200 votes, and Jordan Curtis received 931 votes. The newly elected council members will be sworn in at a called meeting on November 28th. At that meeting, the five council members will then choose the next mayor and vice-mayor. State Representative John Forgety won re-election by a wide margin of about 85% of the vote. Forgety was challenged by an Independent candidate. Congressman Chuck Fleischmann also won re-election with about 76% of the vote.
