ALVEY TO LEAD DOMINION

National & World News

- ◆ After an unseasonably warm winter, residents in parts of the Northeast are bracing for a late season wallop that could drop up to 2 feet of snow in the region. A blizzard warning has been issued by The National Weather Service for several parts of the Northeast.
- ◆ After a Jewish center near Rochester received a bomb threat on Sunday, New York Governor Andrew Cuomo is calling for federal and local authorities to investigate.
- ◆ A 3-year-old girl from Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, died Saturday, after a fire erupted that officials say was ignited by a hoverboard that was recharging. The fire was ruled accidental.
- ◆ President Trump sent his adviser on Israel, Jason Greenblatt, to Israel to restart peace talks between Israelis and Palestinians. Greenblatt will be in Israel for four days to explore ways to restart the peace process.
- ◆ A small earthquake measuring 1.9 was recorded Monday just before 6 a.m. The quake was centered about 5 miles southwest of Calhoun, Tennessee.
- ◆ U.S. stocks closed mixed as traders await a possible interest rate hike by the Fed on Wednesday. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 21.50 at 20,881.48. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 0.87 at 2,373.47, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 14.06 at 5,875.78.
