- ◆ A French-born man identified as 39-year-old Zived Ben Belgacem, was killed by French security forces during a Saturday morning incident at Orly Airport in Paris, France. Belgacem allegedly shouted, "I'm here to die for Allah."
- ◆ In retaliation for what it said was an attack on Russian media in the United States, the Russian parliament has ordered a check of U.S. media outlets operating in the country.
- ◆ President Donald Trump is expected to name attorney George Conway, the husband of White House counselor Kellyanne Conway, to lead the Department of Justice's Civil Division. If confirmed. Conway would be responsible for leading a division in charge of enforcing laws preventing discrimination.
