## **State & Local News**

#### **◆** ATHENS POLICE/FIRE REPORTS FOR FEB.

The Athens City Council heard the police and fire department reports for February at their Tuesday night meeting.

Interim Police Chief Rob Davis reported there were 55 thefts in the city in February. There were 16 assaults, four burglaries, four motor vehicle thefts, three sex offenses, and one robbery. Police issued 323 citations for moving violations. There were 66 traffic accidents, with 11 injuries. There are three vacancies on the police department.

Fire Chief Jim Dyer reported that firefighters responded to 58 calls in February. Ten of those calls were to vehicle accidents, nine were to commercial business places, and there were 18 false alarms. Losses for the month totaled \$394,100. Of that amount, \$330,000 came from a motor home fire on I-75 at exit 49. Losses from a fire at Seaton's were \$15,000, and losses from a fire which damaged several apartments at the McMinn Villa housing project, 212 Westside Avenue, totaled \$47,000.

#### ◆ POWER RATES TO FALL IN APRIL

Athens Utilities Board reports that the price of power in April will drop slightly. The reason is a move from TVA's winter season base rate to what is known as the "transition season" base rate. AUB's Wayne Scarbrough says the difference will save the average AUB customer about \$2.00.

## **National & World News**

- ◆ More than two years into the fight against ISIS, the U.S. is set to convene the largest gathering of the coalition on Wednesday. Secretary of State Rex Tillerson will host the gathering as foreign ministers from all 68 countries in the Global Coalition to Counter ISIS descend on Washington. This is the first time representatives from every country have met since December 2014.
- ◆ Passengers travelling on certain airlines from countries in the Middle East and Africa to the United States will no longer be allowed to carry-on some electronic devices with them. The United Kingdom is also banning many electronic devices from being carried on certain flights.
- ◆ For nearly 40 minutes, President Trump met with the Republican conference behind closed doors, delivering what his aides described as a final sales pitch ahead of Thursday's expected House floor vote on the American Health Care Act (AHCA).


