#### ◆ STORM KNOCKS POWER OFF FOR 1571

Athens Utilities Board says the strong thunderstorms that swept through Athens Tuesday night knocked out power to 1571 customers. The bulk of those were in the Englewood area. AUB's Wayne Scarbrough says an entire circuit out of the Englewood substation went down when a tree fell on primary power lines near the post office. That happened at 7:50 p.m. Crews had power restored by 10:08 p.m. Scarbrough says other outages were spread across AUB's service area with trees and power lines down near Ingleside Elementary School, on Keith Lane, Cedar Springs Road, Hammerhill Road, Lynn Avenue, and County Road 580. Scarbrough says virtually all customers had their power restored by 6:30 Wednesday morning.


