◆ ATHENS ESCAPES STORM UNSCATHED

Most schools dismissed early on Wednesday due to forecasts for severe weather. However, it turned out that the predicted storms had more bark than bite in the Athens area. McMinn County 911 dispatchers reported there were no major problems other than a few downed trees. Athens Utilities Board says they came through the storms very well, with just two storm-related outage events. They were both caused by lightning strikes. Eightyeight customers were affected in the Hilltop Drive area in Niota and four customers were affected by an outage on County Road 267.

National & World News

- ◆ Sarin gas was used in a weapons attack in northern Syria on Tuesday, Turkey's health ministry confirmed after autopsies were conducted on the victims. The death toll has risen to at least 72 civilians, including 20 children.
- ◆ On Tuesday night, North Korea launched a KN-15 missile from its eastern coast into the Sea of Japan. This is the fourth missile test conducted by the North Korean regime this year alone.
- Jobless claims fell lower last week, decreasing by 25,000, according to the latest figures released by the Labor Department on Thursday.
