♦ TWO FATAL WRECKS IN McMINN CO.

A Cleveland man, 24-year-old Christopher A. Clear, Jr., was killed Sunday night when he lost control of his motorcycle on U.S. 411 south of Etowah. The Tennessee Highway Patrol says Clear was traveling southbound on Highway 411 when he ran off the right side of the road at the intersection with County Road 859. His motorcycle then returned to the roadway, but Clear was thrown from the bike and struck the guard rail. He was pronounced dead at the scene. The crash happened shortly before 10 p.m. Trooper Adam Cook investigated.

In the other fatal crash, the THP says 16-year-old Jillian D. Peek of Calhoun was killed when she ran off the side of the road while driving north on County Road 750 around 4 p.m. Sunday. The THP says Miss Peek was traveling "at a high rate of speed" when she went off the right side of the road, hit a culvert, and the vehicle went airborne. She was ejected from the vehicle and was pronounced dead at the scene. She was not wearing any safety restraints.
