STATE & LOCAL NEWS

◆ FUEL TAX BILL PASSES LEGISLATURE

The first gasoline tax increase in Tennessee since 1989 has passed in both the House and the Senate. The vote in the House was 60 to 37. In the Senate, it was 25 to 6. Senator Mike Bell and Rep. John Forgety of McMinn County both voted for the bill. The tax revenue will be used for almost 1000 road projects. The gas tax will go up six cents, starting with four cents per gallon the first year and an additional one cent each in the two following years. Diesel fuel taxes will go up 10 cents a gallon, starting with a six-cent increase the first year and two cents each the next two years. Registration fees for passenger vehicles will go up \$5 per year. Electric car owners will have to pay a \$100 annual fee. At the same time there will be a one percent cut in the sales tax on food, a decrease in corporate franchise and excises taxes, and a continued phase-out of the Hall Income Tax which affects mostly seniors and retirees. The bill passed by the Senate was slightly different than the House bill, so the measure must go back to the House for final action on Monday.
