#### ◆ TBI INVESTIGATES FORMER VEC WORKER

The Tennessee Bureau of Investigation has been asked to help in the investigation of a former Volunteer Energy Cooperative employee who is suspected of theft. The employee was fired from his job in the VEC accounting department four weeks ago, and the Decatur Police Department was asked to investigate allegations of theft. Decatur Police Chief Monty Rowland asked the TBI for assistance. Chief Rowland is not disclosing any details about the investigation at this point, other than to say that investigations of white collar crimes can be lengthy and complicated. Chief Rowland also declined to reveal the former employee's name. However, VEC tells The Morning Fax that he is Jason Kittle. Kittle is 42 and lives in Athens. Sources close to the situation say the allegations involve theft of Volunteer Energy funds, possibly misuse of credit cards potentially totaling into the thousands of dollars. Chief Rowland says evidence gathered in the investigation will be turned over to the district attorney for possible submission to the Meigs County Grand Jury. At this point, no charges have been filed against Kittle.
