♦ HIGHWAY 68 CLOSED FOR NEXT 2 DAYS

The Tennessee Department of Transportation says Highway 68 will be closed today and tomorrow between Spring City and Grandview. The closing had been scheduled for Monday and Tuesday, but was postponed because of the weather. The closing is necessary so crews can repair damage caused by a mud slide last April. TDOT says closing the highway completely will allow workmen to backfill the area with new material, pave, put down pavement markings, and install guardrail.

- ◆ Firefighters are struggling to contain a deadly wildfire that more than doubled in size on Monday. Nearly 9,300 acres of land near Yosemite National Park in California's Sierra Nevada Mountains were charred. The so-called Ferguson Fire, increased to 9,266 acres by Monday evening.
- ◆ A 9-year-old girl died after she was hit in the middle of the night by stray gunfire while inside her New Jersey home. Several shots were fired in Bridgeton at about 12:30 a.m. Tuesday. The bullet entered through a back wall and hit the young girl in her bedroom.
