## The Power of Lightning

Power for 3113 customers served by AUB's Englewood substation was knocked out at 6:30 p.m. Sunday. Residents heard a loud bang when a lightning arrestor in the substation exploded. All three power distribution circuits were knocked off line immediately. AUB's Wayne Scarbrough says the damage was easy to find, with porcelain shrapnel littering the substation grounds. (See photo below) Multiple crews quickly got to work, cleared all of the issues, and restored power at 7:50 p.m. Scarbrough says the lightning arrestor in question may have been damaged by a lightning strike during recent electrical storms. He says sometimes a damaged arrestor can continue to operate for some time with hairline cracks that allow moisture to collect until ambient conditions trigger a reaction of moisture flashing to steam in an explosion of porcelain.
