♦ARREST MADE IN FEBRUARY SHOOTING

Athens Police say they have identified the suspect involved in a

shooting incident which occurred on Forrest Avenue last month. Joseph Kibodeaux, age 27, of Athens, was arrested last Thursday, after APD officer Jason Roberts located him and took him into custody. He is currently in the McMinn County jail under a \$250,000 bond and is facing several charges. The



incident began on February 12th when a woman, who was driving on Forrest Avenue, called 911 and reported to dispatchers that someone had fired a gun at her from another vehicle. The woman said that she had been shot, but actually was injured by flying glass. After the shooting, police worked on several leads and obtained enough evidence to seek a Grand Jury indictment against Kibodeaux. APD Chief Cliff Couch said in a release that Detective Gary Miller, many other APD officers, the District Attorney's Office and the Drug Task Force worked on solving the case.

MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks were mixed as investors continued to weigh global growth prospects. Industrials and consumer discretionary were the best-performing sectors, while the technology and financials sectors lagged. U.S. Treasuries were higher, while yields fell.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 15 points or 0.1% to 25,517. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 2 points or 0.1% to 2,798, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 5 points or 0.1% to 7,638.
