Two Charged in Meigs Murder

Two people have been arrested in connection with a murder in Meigs County. TBI agents joined forces with the Meigs, McMinn, and Monroe county sheriff's departments and the Decatur Police Dept. to arrest Clifford Howard, 39, on charges of murdering 59year-old Roger Dale Miller. Miller's body was found by a school bus driver off Eaves Ferry Road in Decatur last week. The victim's ex-wife was also arrested. Howard was charged with 1st Degree Murder, Felony Murder, Aggravated Robbery Aggravated Kidnapping, and Theft over \$10,000. Howard was in custody in the Monroe County Jail on unrelated charges. He is being held without bond. Stacy Marie Miller was charged with facilitation of 1st Degree Murder, Felony Murder, Aggravated Robbery, Kidnapping, and Theft over \$10,000. She was arrested in McMinn County after a short foot pursuit. Bond was set at \$375,000.





Police & Fire Dept. Reports

Members of the Athens City Council heard reports from the police and fire departments about activity during April at Tuesday night's council meeting.

- Police Chief Cliff Couch reported there were 72 thefts in Athens in April, 17 assaults, 15 burglaries, eight motor vehicle thefts, three robberies, and three sex offenses. Offices issued 237 tickets for moving violations. There were 82 traffic accidents in Athens in April, with 19 injuries. Chief Couch reported there is one vacancy on the police force.
- Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth reported that firefighters responded to 69 calls in April. Thirty-two calls were for rescue and emergency medical service. There were six fire calls and 14 false alarms. Firefighters also responded to 15 motor vehicle accidents, 11 with injuries.

- Adeline Underhill, age 8, of Maryville died Tuesday. Arrangements will be announced by Bowers Funeral Home.




