- The Annual Veterans Day ceremony will be held Monday at 11 a.m. in front of the VFW Post on North Congress Parkway in Athens. It's a special Memories Day Service. There will be the reading of the veterans. The honor guard will be making a special presentation including the folding of the flag. The POW/MIA Table will also be on display. There will be no speaker this year. Lunch will be served following the service.
- Meigs County will also have a Memorial Day service at 11 a.m. in front of the Meigs County Courthouse. The service will end with a firing detail, the sounding of Taps, and raising the flag to full staff. Veterans are encouraged to wear their medals and ribbons.
